

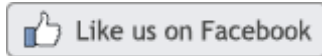

How is the fit?

Last year, when the results of the dues trials were read in Lodge, I wondered why so many relatively new Brothers stopped attending Lodge, stopped communicating, stopped paying dues. Months later it still is on my mind. What did we miss in our process. When we consider an applicant for membership the process focuses on determining if the man meets the requirements of Freemasonry. Is he meeting his financial obligations? What are the home conditions? Does he believe in temperance? Is his wife in favor of his application? Has he been convicted of a criminal offence? We ask these questions to determine if he will fit these long established requirements. I carefully reviewed the Petition for the Degrees, read again the Six Steps to Initiation. I searched the internet and learned that several Grand Lodges have a process which is similar to our Six Steps to Initiation. This process uses multiple one on one meetings, with homework readings and questions from both sides. During these meetings the Lodge officers are explained. The history of Freemasonry and the history of our Lodge is reviewed. The three degrees are briefly discussed. The agenda of the typical Lodge meeting is covered. The expected dress code is reviewed. The feedback from this six step process, the petition and investigation results are presented to the Lodge for consideration and ballot.

Becoming a Freemason is not an event. It is a process that takes time, both mental and physical, it costs money and requires commitment.

Not only do we need to determine if the man fits the requirements of Freemasonry, we need to determine if Freemasonry fits the man's requirements. His hopes, needs and desires. Only then is the investigation complete.

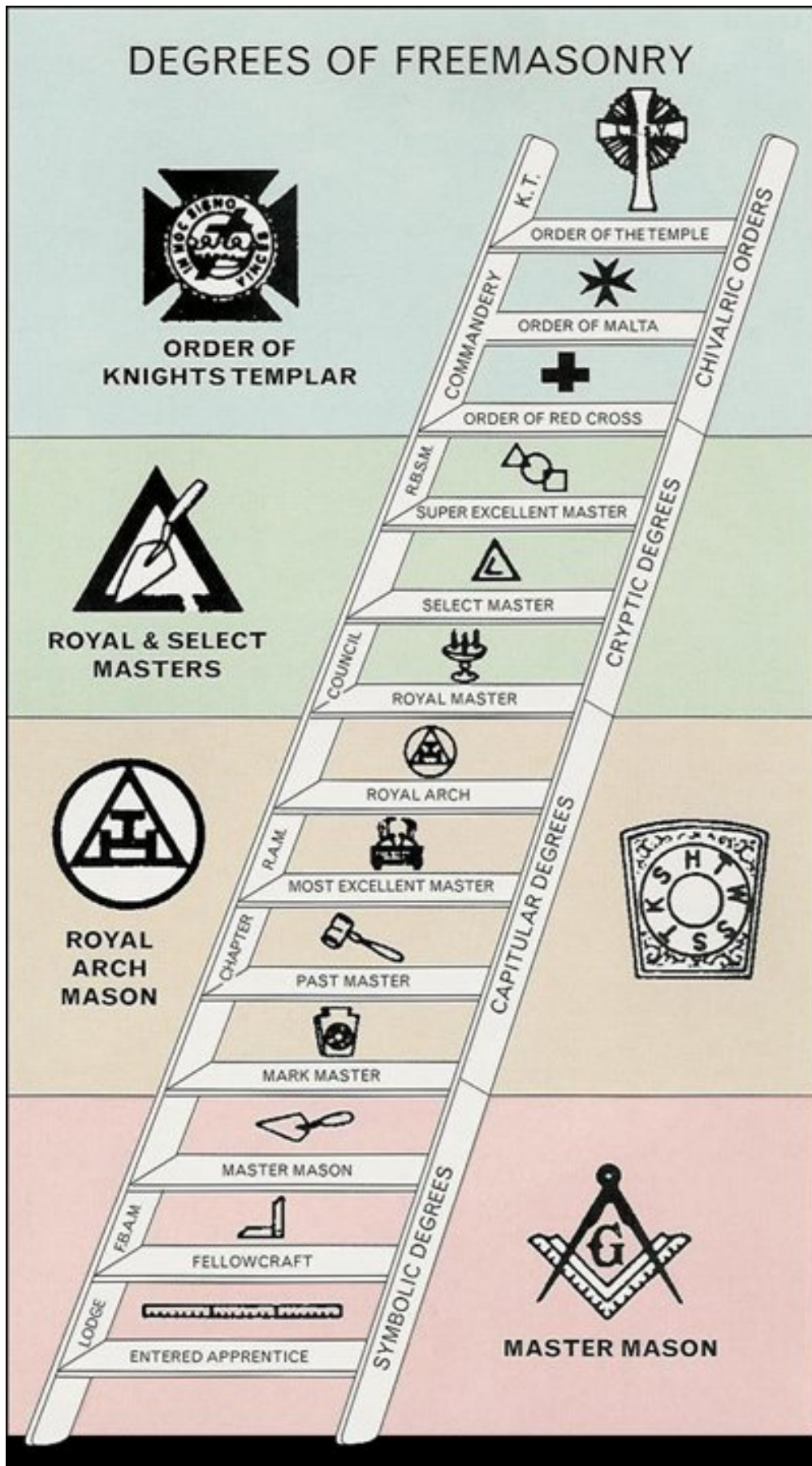
