

Ritual - To memorize or not to memorize

A recent article in a Scottish Rite magazine by III. Gail Kemp 33°, Past Grand Master of Indiana titled "Whatever Happened to Memorization?" explores the causes of why memorized ritual is becoming more difficult to have. He states that with the decline of lodge membership there are fewer brothers who are willing or able to memorize the work. With the introduction of smart phones and tablets, which places a wealth of information at one's fingertips, schools no longer emphasize memorization. The world we live in has many more demands on our time than in the past. Brother Kemp proposes several options such as degree teams, either inside or outside a lodge, recognizing good ritualist via a certificate or pin. He also proposes the option of electronic presentation of the ritual.

At the School of Instruction held last month at Jackson Lodge #17 we learned that the Grand Lodge of Michigan has no intention of abandoning the memorization of ritual. Worshipful Brother Frank Peters, Regional Grand Lecturer, presented the future requirements of certification of lodge officers. Currently certification of officers is voluntary. A lodge officer may request the opportunity to demonstrate his proficiency and if he is successful he will be certified in the office he holds. The certification requirements that exist today cover both the current office and the next office in line. For example, the Junior Warden requirements are:

The Junior Warden must be capable of performing all the work in the South on all three degrees.

- Give 1 obligation
- Sit in the West for opening and closing of the Lodge in all three degrees
- Instruct the candidate on how to approach the Altar
- Instruct the candidate on how to wear his apron
- Go from Labor to Refreshment.
- Go from Refreshment to Labor.
- Perform his work at the Middle Chamber.

This must be performed without the aid of an open ritual. Although it is not mentioned specifically I assume that the limited use of a prompter would be acceptable.

The program of officer certification would insure that a brother was ready, from the viewpoint of ritual, to move up to the next office.

In days gone by the proficiency demonstration contained more ritual memorization and the only printed ritual was the single letter key. To be successful in learning the ritual and demonstrating proficiency a brother most likely would have to work with one or more brothers to decipher the code. The memorization of a significant portion of each degree ritual was required to demonstrate proficiency which went a long way in preparing a brother for future offices he might hold. The required demonstration of proficiency was decreased from several pages to a few sentences further deemphasizing the need for memorization. With the introduction of the complete ritual in printed words, the need to work with other brothers on proficiency was greatly decreased.

Brother Kemp closes his article with the following: "Remember ritual is important but it must be presented in an enjoyable and inspirational manner. Just as important, however, is what do you and your lodge do with the lessons presented in all of our rituals; are they merely words or are they put into practice?"

This is a most interesting and thought-provoking question.
