





Open House Wednesday, May 15, 2019

Charity


The Merriam-Webster dictionary defines charity generosity and helpfulness especially toward the needy or suffering. Jackson Lodge #17 practices charity through donations to the Food Bank, sponsoring the Michigan Child Identification Program at the local Kids Fest, Scholarships, and Books for Bikes. Each donation occurs one time per year. Not often enough to remind us our community of one of the key values Freemasonry. Let's go back for a moment and review an excerpt from "It's about time" (the report reprinted in the first four Trestleboards of 2019). "Masons are not visible in the daily life of their communities. Their identity is frequently misunderstood and misrepresented in the press and by religious critics. There is little reserve of positive memories of activity remaining in our communities. Within eye and ear range of the public, Masons have failed to perform what they profess; consequently, they have lost their significance within the context of community." Something to ponder. A bitter pill to swallow.

During the debate at the April regular communication on a proposed major expenditure a past master commented that we should give some of our monthly lodge income to charities rather than put it all in the bank or spend it on the large expenditure being discussed by the brothers. Since this wasn't directly related to the topic at hand the discussion moved on. I mentally filed the comment away for future thought.

Last week, as I entered Sam's Club, two women were handing out flyers. I took one and put it in my pocket. When I returned home and read it I learned it was from a church collecting personal care items for the "Hands and Feet Personal Needs Pantry". As I thought about this request I concluded that there were, most likely, other charities in Jackson county that would like a donation. Here's a thought. Would the brothers of Jackson #17 be willing to donate small amounts, with Grand Lodge matching funds, each month, to multiple charities?

This would fit perfectly with a comment from "It's about time". Public awareness of Masonry begins at a grassroots level. Masons must be visible in the community to demonstrate Masonic values in many aspects of their lives.

This would be a constant reminder to both the brothers and the community and reinforce the masonic value of charity.






