

# **Going through the chairs**

During a recent phone conversation with a new candidate he asked how the lodge was governed and how officers were selected. I explained that unlike any other organization that I was aware of the officers were in a moving line. Beginning with the Junior Steward then progressing to Senior Steward, Junior Deacon, Senior Deacon, Junior Warden, Senior Warden and then Worshipful Master. He asked if there was an election or do they just move up? I explained that once a year there is an election that begins with a nomination. Usually the Senior Warden is nominated to Worshipful Master. There is a motion to cast a unanimous ballot. Once that is completed the Worshipful Master elect proposes his slate of officers again in keeping with the progressive line. Nominations are closed and the ballot cast. The candidate commented that this "shows a lot of trust in both the process and the brotherhood". Yes it does and it has functioned well for 300 years. I mentioned that I had served the Craft as Worshipful Master three times. He asked if each time I had to start over again in the line. I responded that the second and third time there was an opening somewhere in the line that I could, at the pleasure of the Worshipful Master, fill.

I found a good explanation of the progressive line in of all places in the book "Freemasonry for Dummies"

Masonic officers are generally part of what is called a progressive line, also known as "going through the chairs." It is a line of succession that moves up one position at a time from one year to the next. When a man is appointed to the Junior Steward's position, in a perfect set of circumstances, seven years later he will be Worshipful Master. Although this curious plan for leadership has its drawbacks, it was designed based on the philosophy of equality among Masons. The progressive line is most common in the United States, but it exists in many other jurisdictions, as well.

The founders of our fraternity designed the offices so that as a Brother moves up, the complexity of ritual increases as does the responsibility in assisting the Worshipful Master in the running of the lodge.

As the Brother progresses up the line the other line officers and Brothers can observe him develop in leadership, public speaking and running a communication or conferring a degree. By the time a Brother reaches Worshipful Master his strengths and weaknesses are well known. This provides the Brothers with a roadmap of where the incoming Worshipful Master might need help.

My closing words again were found in "Freemasonry for Dummies"

There is supposed to be no politicking or campaigning for an officer's position. In the ideal lodge situation, each man simply advances each year, learning each position's duties and a portion of the Masonic ceremonies. By the time he becomes Worshipful Master of the lodge, he has sat in every chair except, perhaps, the Secretary and Treasurer. He has learned public speaking, management of a volunteer organization, decorum, and responsibility. And eliminating the annual popularity contest for election that many groups suffer results in a smoother, friendlier line of succession. Any man, regardless of his social, business, or economic position outside the lodge room, may aspire to be Master of his lodge.

Very well said and big shoes to fill. It is our duty to carry on the tradition of the oldest, largest fraternity in the world.


Dear Brother's,


