



#### **The 1st Third Party**

2020 marks a presidential election year. Our political system is based on two parties. One party is occupying the White House and the other has more than a dozen candidates vying for position. We haven't heard much from the few third parties and typically they don't play a significant role in the election process. This was not the case for the first third party. This party was the first political party in the United States to hold a nominating convention and the first to announce a platform. The entrance of this party effected the outcome of a presidential election helping the incumbent win by a large margin. The same year seven electoral votes from Vermont went to the third party candidate. One governor from that party was elected and members of Congress from six states were elected. What was the name of the party? The "Anti-Masonic Party". What is the why and how of this party? In the 1820s Batavia Lodge #433, Grand Lodge of New York was infiltrated by William Morgan, who was a drifter with no steady source of income. He passed himself off as a Freemason for the purpose of gaining access to the ritual and secrets of Freemasonry. Morgan and a local newspaper publisher, David Miller, planned to print a book disclosing the ritual. As the date of publication approached local Freemasons reportedly began

campaign of harassment of both Morgan and Miller. They both were arrested for indebtedness and Morgan was arrested for petty larceny. Morgan was bailed out of jail that evening, rumored by a group of Freemasons, never to be heard from or seen again. As word of Morgan's disappearance spread so grew the brutality of the kidnapping. Twenty grand jury hearings were held resulting in fifty-four Freemasons being indicted. Ten were convicted of kidnapping but since no body was found none were convicted of Morgan's murder. Lodge membership in New York state declined sharply. Anti-Masonic hysteria prevailed throughout the United States for the next 20 years. By the 1840s the fraternity began a slow recovery.

And now you know the story of the Morgan Affair and the first third party.




