## **The Ring**

Last week my granddaughter and her boyfriend stopped by for a visit. Since her boyfriend is a pilot for a major airline our visits have turned into conversations with the glass storm door between us to provide social distancing. As we chatted, she asked if I could suggest any good movies to watch. A recent Facebook post that put our "stay at home" policy in perspective by reminding us that Anne Frank and 7 others hid for 761 days, was fresh in my mind, so I said "watch the movie Defiance. You can get it on Netflix or Amazon Prime." I told her to call me after she watched the movie and I would have a couple of stories for her.

The movie is about the four Beilski brothers whose parents were executed by the Nazis. The movie documents the activities of the brothers. Several years ago, while on vacation in Fort Myers, Florida, I had the opportunity to hear a presentation by a daughter of one of the brothers.

My granddaughter called me after watching the movie and I related the following stories to her:

Years ago I met a laboratory equipment salesman from Holland, MI. As we got to know each other we would share personal stories. I knew he was Dutch, born in Canada after WWII. He told me during WWII his parents lived in the Netherlands. They were Christians and hid Jews from the Nazis on their farm. The Nazis found out and executed his father. His mother met another man and they continued to hide Jews. Long after the war ended the Israeli government presented a medal to his mother for her heroic actions.

My father was a Freemason and as was typical of the time I never heard him discuss Freemasonry with family or friends. He always wore his square and compass pin on the suit coat that he wore to work, church, out to dinner etc. One evening my dad, mom and I went to Hudson's to buy shoes for my dad. We sat down in the shoe department and a salesman approached. He looked at my father, they shook hands and immediately became immersed in a conversation as though no one else was around. The salesman showed my dad his gold initial ring. He slid it off his finger, flipped the front panel and slid it back on his finger revealing the square and compass. The salesman went on to say that he lived in the Netherlands during WWII and since Hitler and the Nazis hated Freemasonry and were executing them, they hid their membership with these special rings. They ended their conversation and my dad selected a pair of shoes and we headed home. I remember that event from 60 years ago like it was yesterday.

Although the pain and suffering Freemasons endured at the hands of the Nazis was minor in comparison, many Brothers lost their lives. Here is an excerpt from Wikipediatitled Suppression of Freemasonry The Nazis claimed that high-degree Masons were willing members of the Jewish conspiracy and that Freemasonry was one of the causes of Germany's defeat in World War I. In Mein Kampf, Adolf Hitler wrote that Freemasonry has succumbed to the Jews and has become an excellent instrument to fight for their aims and to use their strings to pull the upper strata of society into their designs. He continued, "The general pacifistic paralysis of the national instinct of self-preservation begun by Freemasonry" is then transmitted to the masses of society by the press. In 1933 Hermann Göring, the President and one of the key figures in the process of Gleichschaltung ("synchronization"), stated "in National Socialist Germany, there is no place for Freemasonry".

The Enabling Act (Ermächtigungsgesetz in German) was passed by Germany's parliament (the Reichstag) on March 23, 1933. Using the Act, on January 8, 1934, the German Ministry of the Interior ordered the disbandment of Freemasonry, and confiscation of the property of all Lodges; stating that those who had been members of Lodges when Hitler came to power, in January 1933, were prohibited from

holding office in the Nazi party or its paramilitary arms, and were ineligible for appointment in public service. Consistently considered an ideological foe of Nazism in their world perception (Weltauffassung), special sections of the Security Service and later the Reich Security Main Office were established to deal with Freemason.

On August 8, 1935, as Führer and Chancellor, Adolf Hitler announced in the Nazi Party newspaper, Voelkischer Beobachter, the final dissolution of all Masonic Lodges in Germany. The article accused a conspiracy of the Fraternity and World Jewry of seeking to create a World Republic. In 1937 Joseph Goebbels inaugurated an "Anti-Masonic Exposition" to display objects seized by the state. The Ministry of Defense forbade officers from becoming Freemasons, with officers who remained as Masons being sidelined.

During the war, Freemasonry was banned by edict in all countries that were either allied with the Nazis or under Nazi control, including Norway and France. Anti-Masonic exhibitions were held in many occupied countries. Field-Marshal Friedrich Paulus was denounced as a "High-grade Freemason" when he surrendered to the Soviet Union in 1943.

In 1943, the anti-Masonic propaganda film forces occultes was produced in Nazi-occupied France, accusing the Freemasons of conspiring with Jews and Anglo-American nations to encourage France into a war with Germany.

The preserved records of the RSHA-i.e., Reichssicherheitshauptamt or the Office of the High Command of Security Service, which pursued the racial objectives of the SS through the Race and Resettlement Office-document the persecution of Freemasons. The number of Freemasons from Nazi occupied countries who were killed is not accurately known, but it is estimated that between 80,000 and 200,000 Freemasons were murdered under the Nazi regime.

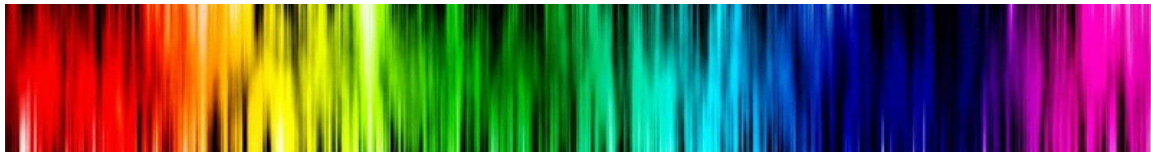

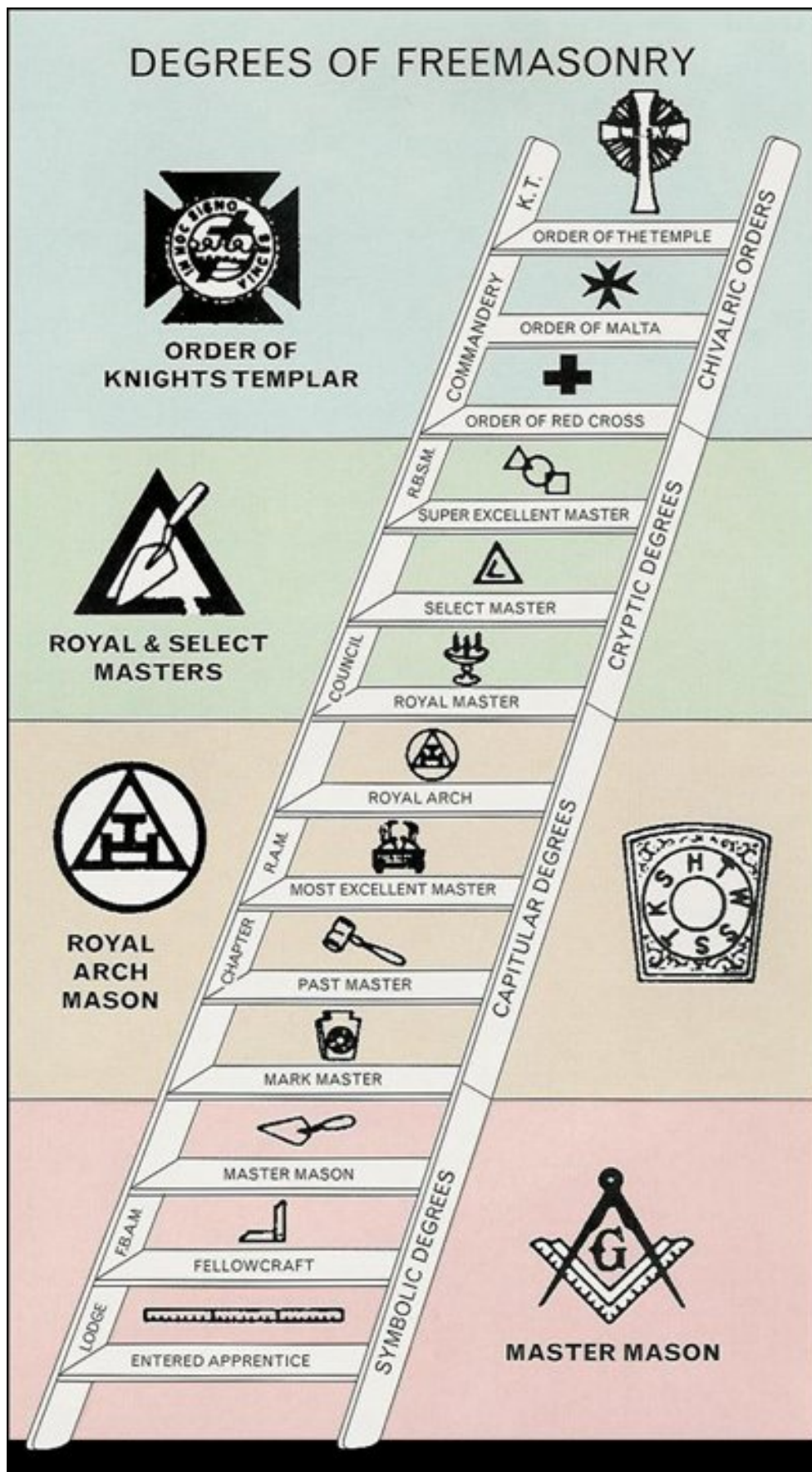

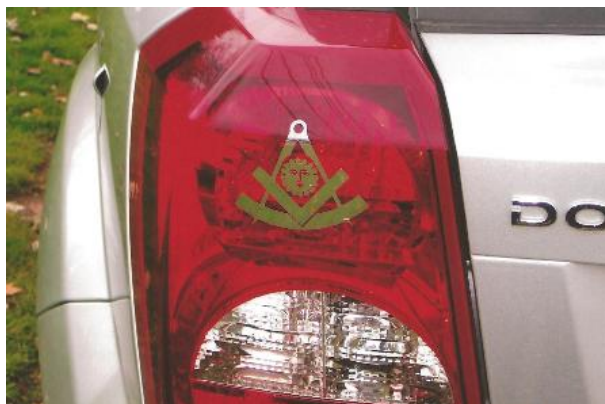
